We have two Practice Nurses, one healthcare practitioner and three phlebotomists who can assist with blood letting, chronic disease management and dressings etc.

We also continue as a Training Practice and will offer appointments with these GP trainees and medical students as they develop their clinical expertise.

Community Treatment Centre

You may have been invited attend to North Ayr Health Centre, Glenmuir Place for shingles or pneumococcal vaccination recently. The team there also offer general nursing appointments and run clinics for patients of the surgery on Wednesday and Thursday afternoon for the likes of dressings, injections, blood letting. Whilst the surgery is happy to see you, we understand this may be more convenient for some patients. To arrange an appointment, contact the surgery and let the reception team know you'd like to attend North Ayr and the team will book you the next suitable appointment.

Armed Forces Personnel & Veterans

The Armed Forces Covenant


- The Armed Forces community should enjoy the same standard of, and access to healthcare as that received by any other UK citizen in the area they live.
- Family members should retain their place on any NHS waiting list, if moved around the UK due to the service person being posted.
- Veterans should receive priority treatment for a condition which relates to their service, subject to clinical need.
- Those injured in service should be cared for in a way that reflects the nation's moral obligation to them, by healthcare professionals who understand the Armed Forces culture.

Health Screening Events

We recently invited patients aged 45-65 who had not attended for some time to a drop in screening event. The event was so successful we offered a second date 4 weeks later. The team offered lifestyle advice, urinalysis and blood testing, blood pressure measurement etc. As a result of these events we identified a few patients with new diagnoses of diabetes and hypertension in patients who may not otherwise have attended.

Cardiovascular risks were scored as follows -



Cardiovascular Risk Scoring


Less than 10% - Normal result

Between 10% and 20% - Lifestyle and dietary changes recommended – you could consider starting statin therapy if you wish to discuss this, please contact the surgery to arrange a consultation Greater than 20% - Statin therapy is recommended as well as lifestyle and dietary changes

Further events may be offered in the future. In the meantime, the Practice Nurses are happy to offer you a Well Person Check in a booked appointment.

Patient Contact Audit

A previous audit of patient contacts revealed that 36% of activity was completed by the admin team without any other intervention. Further data was collected to establish what types of contacts were being managed. The chart below shows the outcomes of 525 patient contacts collected over a week in December 2022.



One result that stood out from this was the number of patients phoning to check prescriptions are ready. We offer a same day / next day service and will contact you if there is a problem.

Is there something we can do differently to reassure you your prescription is processed?

<u>Prescription Ordering and Preferred Pharmacy</u>

- Repeat prescriptions ordered before 12pm will be ready for collection at 3pm on the same working day.
- Please call the Prescription Line on **01292 272140** or order online using the prescription order form at **www.medicayr.co.uk.** You can also order in person at reception.
- If a prescription you order is not due or there is a problem we will contact you to let you know.
- If you wish your prescription to be collected by a preferred pharmacy, please complete a consent form available from reception or on our website.
- If you wish to change your preferred pharmacy, please complete a consent form for the new pharmacy and your record will be updated.


We have seen an increase in patients requesting their prescription go to a different pharmacy to that they have consented to. This has caused confusion where patients expect this to be a permanent change. We will be contacting all patients with a preferred pharmacy to ensure we have up-to-date information in the coming weeks.

Appointment Attendance

The chart below shows that fewer patients are failing to attend appointment than in 2019.

Please remember to cancel your appointment if you no longer require it or are unable to attend.

This allows other patients to be seen and helps reduce the waiting time for appointments overall.
