- 1.Nurse Practitioner update: both in post. One a paramedic, one has A &E & minor injury background.
 - Minor Illness/Minor Injury Stream seems to be going well. It has had a good impact on My Health On Line. There are fewer emergencies later in the day. Most people happy to see Nurse Practitioners. They see approx. 30-40 appointments and have a lead GP they can refer to if necessary.
