

COVID-19 Vaccination:

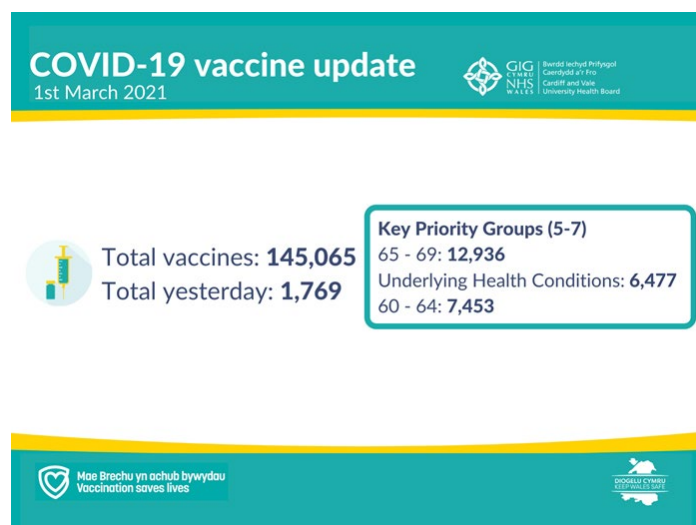
Programme update 1 March 2021

Overview

Our ambition is to protect our Cardiff and Vale population as quickly as possible with vaccination for Covid-19. A vaccination programme on such a large scale requires a multi-faceted approach and a mixed model of delivery. The model in Cardiff and Vale includes mobile teams, mass vaccination centres, GP Practices and healthcare 'hubs'.

Operational Delivery:

To date we have vaccinated 145,065 people in the priority cohorts as set by JCVI which is 29% of our total population.



We are continuing to invite priority group 5, age 65-69 to their GP Practice, and priority group 6, 16-64 with underlying health conditions and unpaid carers, and Priority Group 7, age 60-64, to a Mass Vaccination Centre.

An online form will also be made available this week for unpaid carers to register their details with us, so we can schedule their appointment. We will provide a phone number for anyone who would like some assistance to complete the form.



Invitation for vaccination

We are inviting priority groups in line with JCVI guidance. The table below shows our current plan in relation to each group.

<p>Priority Group 1 Adult Care Home residents and staff</p>	<p>Vaccinated by our Mobile Vaccination Teams. Second doses are scheduled at 8 weeks later.</p> <p>Some care home staff may have been vaccinated at one of our centres and they will automatically be contacted for their second dose.</p>
<p>Priority Group 2 80 years and over and frontline health and social care staff</p>	<p>All of this group have been offered appointments.</p> <p>If aged 80 and over and you have not been invited for your FIRST dose please contact your GP Practice.</p> <p>GP Practices will contact patients directly for their second dose so please remain patient.</p> <p>Frontline health and social care staff - if you have not been contacted for your FIRST dose please email cvuhb.massimms@wales.nhs.uk</p> <p>Second doses will be automatically scheduled and you will receive a text message. If you do receive a cancellation text this will be followed up with a new appointment by text message. If you do not receive a cancellation message your original appointment date remains.</p>
<p>Priority Group 3 aged 75-79</p>	<p>All of this group have been offered appointments at their GP Practice.</p> <p>If you have not been invited for your FIRST dose please contact your GP Practice.</p> <p>GP Practices will contact patients directly for their second dose so please remain patient.</p>

<p>Priority Group 6 age 16-64 with underlying health conditions and unpaid carers</p>	<p>This group are currently being contacted by the Health Board to attend a Mass Vaccination Centre.</p> <p>People who have been identified as having an underlying health condition in line with JCVI guidance or an unpaid carer have been added to priority group 6.</p> <p>These appointments will be automatically scheduled and you will receive a letter in the post.</p> <p>Please be patient while we work through this group.</p> <p>We will communicate further guidance in the next few weeks on how to register if you believe you have not been invited and fall within the guidance.</p>
<p>Priority Group 7 age 60-64</p>	<p>This group will be contacted by the Health Board to attend a Mass Vaccination Centre.</p> <p>Please be patient and you will receive an appointment letter in the post.</p>
<p>Priority Group 8 age 55-59</p>	<p>We will communicate where this group will be invited in due course once we have made our way through the majority of groups 5-7. Please be patient and you will be contacted directly</p>



Priority Group 9 aged 50-54	We will communicate where this group will be invited in due course once we have made our way through the majority of groups 5-7. Please be patient and you will be contacted directly
Priority Group 10 Rest of population	We will communicate where this group will be invited in due course once we have made our way through the majority of groups 5-7. Please be patient and you will be contacted directly

Key achievements from last week

- We ramped up second doses of the Pfizer vaccine, delivering approximately 1,400 doses every day.
- We have now vaccinated over 60% of people aged 65-69 in GP practices.

Week ahead

- Following a planned reduction to vaccine supply over the past two weeks due to the national supply chain, vaccine supply will increase again, with a significant delivery of the Oxford Astra Zeneca vaccine expected next week (8th March), enabling further acceleration of vaccinations.
- A media day is planned at each of our Mass Vaccination Centres tomorrow (2nd March), offering a further opportunity for the media to profile the Mass Vaccination Programme in Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan. This coincides with Wales passing the milestone of one million people in Wales having been vaccinated.
- Public Health Consultant, Lorna Bennett will be attending a webinar with Cardiff Council to answer common questions the council is receiving from residents about the vaccination programme.
- GP Practices will continue offering appointments to priority group 5, age 65-69 with over 4,000 vaccinations again expected to be delivered in primary care this week. They are on track to complete first doses for priority group 5 before the end of March.
- Our Mass Vaccination Centres in Pentwyn and Barry will be delivering the Oxford Astra Zeneca vaccine to priority group 6, age 16-64 with underlying health conditions that could become seriously ill from Covid, and unpaid carers.
- Second doses of the Pfizer vaccine will continue being delivered at the Mass Vaccination Centre in Splott and the satellite clinic at UHL.
