GP Practices across Wales have over <u>19 million consultations</u> each year; it is no surprise that patients sometimes find it difficult to get an appointment.

Practices often struggle to deal with patient demand for appointments and at present have <u>no more capacity</u> to resolve the issue.

GP Practices across Wales face the challenge of providing the highest level of primary healthcare with <u>finite resources</u>.

This leaflet outlines ways in which together we can achieve this goal.

DOES THIS MEAN I SHOULDN'T RING MY GP?

Absolutely not

GP's want to use their skills and expertise on patients that need to see them the most.

Many GP's have now introduced a telephone triage system whereby GPs will speak to patients on the telephone before assessing the need for the patient to be seen in an appointment. The system means that they can deal with more patients per day.

Your GP may suggest seeing another healthcare professional more suited to your needs.
